**ON THIS**, the 19<sup>th</sup> day of July, 2016, the City Council of the City of Borger, Texas, met in regular session with five (5) members present, when among other business transacted, the following action was taken:

The Mayor introduced the following resolution:

**WHEREAS**, the City Council of this City heretofore appointed Mr. William "Bill" Carder as a member of the Board of Directors of the **CANADIAN RIVER MUNICIPAL WATER AUTHORITY** for the term ending July 31, 2016, pursuant to the provisions of Chapter 243 of the Laws passed by the Regular Session of the Texas Legislature in 1953, as amended; and,

WHEREAS, such office has now become vacant by reason of expiration of term; and,

**WHEREAS**, in the performance of its duty to do so under said Law, this City Council desires to officially appoint a person qualified to fill the vacancy occasioned as aforesaid, therefore,

 That, Mr. William "Bill" Carder, a qualified voter and a property owning taxpayer of the City of Borger who is not a member of the governing body or an employee of said City, be and is hereby reappointed to the Board of Directors of the CANADIAN RIVER MUNICIPAL WATER AUTHORITY for the term beginning August 1<sup>st</sup>, 2016 and ending July 31<sup>st</sup>, 2018.
